DREAMS & VISION PAST, PRESENT & FUTURE

Many times, in looking ahead, we fail to recall all that has happened before. There have been many dreams and visions of ours in the past that have materialized.

Early in 2003, we realized the major need for better fire service. Through much discussion, we tackled the problem of underfunded volunteer fire departments neglected by previous commissions and today, we have an excellent fire department, which lowered our ISO rating from a nine to four. Special thanks to Chief Cooper, Pam Tucker, and then Commissioner Steve Brown—a dream and vision realized.

Later that year, the new library began after several design changes and is now the most visited library in the CSRA. In the following year, we established the entire county as a no smoking county much to the delight of the American Cancer Society and the Board of Health—special thanks to Commissioner Tommy Mercer. We also envisioned a new Emergency Management building, Sheriff's sub-station, a new Animal Control facility, a new Health Department, a new tag and tax office, a new recycle center, and a renovated Appling Courthouse. All have been in service for several years.

A trip to Ft Lauderdale, Florida made me notice the very attractive and effective backlit street signs. It took a new county engineer to get it done, but we did, thanks to Matt Schlachter. Even before I took office, I had a strong feeling that we needed our own Chamber of Commerce and our own Convention and Visitors Bureau. Through the assistance of those independent bodies, that has been obtained. We needed shopping opportunities badly; the Target Center, Home Depot, Wal-Mart, Lowes, and many others have arrived—thanks to Frank and Joe Mullins, Blanchard and Calhoun, Hull-Storey and others. We needed additions to the area around I-20 and Lewiston Road. Welcome another Wal-Mart, Kroger, and several others—thanks again to Blanchard and Calhoun and the Carter family.

A vision of mine for several years has become the number one attraction for families of Columbia County and that is Evans Towne Center Park. It took several years to accomplish, but it is so nice to see all the family activities there. The concerts are great and the fireworks are unbelievable as was witnessed at "Thunder Over

Evans" (thanks to Donnie Thompson and Andy Jones). There is also as much satisfaction in seeing the usage every day of the week by walkers, runners, playground users, splash pad players, and loungers in the grass and on the benches—thanks to county staff and my fellow commissioners. A hospital for Columbia County and a "Downtown" for Evans are dreams that are well on their way.

There are many more things that have been accomplished in the past few years and the total thanks must go to you, the citizens of Columbia County for you are the ones that funded all of these improvements. Your willingness to approve bond issues and SPLOST programs have made all of these items and more, possible. Your dreams and vision have made this county great! You have not only funded the "Quality of Life" projects but also the infrastructure that allows access. More has been accomplished in a shorter length of time here than anywhere in the state.

So, why all of this bravado?

Last month, we talked briefly about attempting to expedite the recent dreams and vision of our citizens that was expressed in our "Vision 2035" study conducted as part of our ten year "Master Growth Management Plan" update. To be able to provide the amenities desired would be impossible without revenue beyond property taxes, which we will not raise. The most practical avenue is to issue capital improvement bonds and be able to provide these additions almost immediately. A few of the improvements that would be considered are:

- Several public parks similar, but slightly smaller than Evans Towne Center Park, in Martinez, Grovetown, and Riverwood;
- Completion of the Euchee Creek Greenway and the Lakeside Park off Blue Ridge Dr;
- A new library in downtown Grovetown;
- Expansion of the parking at Savannah Rapids Pavilion, Patriots Park and Blanchard Woods Park;
- Allow the Cultural Center to be enlarged to two thousand seats;

- Provide a parking deck at the new Evans Plaza;
- Completion of the multi-use trail from Evans Towne Park to the Savannah Rapids Pavilion;
- Expand Training Facilities for the Sheriff's Office and Fire Department;
- Several storm water and transportation improvements.



WHAT ABOUT THE HOSPITAL???

The most frequently asked question today is, "where are we with the building of our new hospital"?

As you know, the parent company of Doctors Hospital has filed suit to stop the building of our hospital. One suit has been thrown out and another is pending. Hopefully, it will be settled by this fall. Doctors Hospital thought we needed a hospital when they submitted their proposal, but since they were not selected they apparently have changed their mind. Tragically, if they are successful in their litigation, there will be no new hospital at all. Augusta University has the approval and is the only entity that can build. Hopefully, the courts will allow them to proceed. We need our own primary health provider.

This would be a major undertaking by the citizens of the county. It would advance the special requests by our citizenS by many years. Are we willing to accelerate once again our own dreams and visions? You may have the opportunity in November to be a part of this proposal. Next month we will have a detailed project list with project cost and detailed calculations of bond costs. We have done this many times before but are we ready for more additions to our long list of major improvement accomplishments? I hope so. It is really special to see dreams and visions become reality.

SCAMS DON'T FALL FOR THEM!



When approached with the right situation, we can all be susceptible to falling for a scam. Unfortunately, doing good and helping others, while noble, can make us targets of scammers and fraudsters.

ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF SCAMS IN THE U.S. IS AROUND \$50 BILLION*

We shouldn't stop being kind or giving, but learning the "red flags" of scams and practicing safe habits may keep you, or someone you love, from becoming a statistic.

LOTTERY SCAM

The promise of a big win is hard to resist. A "red flag" of a lottery scam is the requirement to send money to release the funds or pay taxes and fees.

PERSON -IN- NEED SCAM

Receiving a frantic phone call that involves a person in need can cause panic and confusion. Create a "red flag" by making sure family members can recognize these scams.

The Mystery Shopper Scam

You may have seen these incentives. A "company" offers you the opportunity to be hired as a paid mystery shopper. They tell you they will send you money to purchase merchandise

from a store and evaluate the service you receive. When you get the check, you'll discover it's for more money than it should be. The scammer will then ask you to send or wire back a portion of the money to them – before you cash the check. The check will almost certainly turn out to be a fake, and once you have sent the money, there is no way to recover the funds sent to them.

The Check or Money Order Scam

This con works in reverse to the usual money transfer scheme. Here, someone sends you a check or money order to pay for something you are selling. But the indication of a scam becomes evident when the buyer "accidentally" sends you an amount more than the purchase price.

They will then try to convince you to deposit the check or money order, and simply send a money transfer containing the extra amount back to them. In most cases, the check turns out to be counterfeit, and the scammer makes off with the amount you sent back.
