**Subject:** **Temporary Reduced Speed on a section of Washington Road (S.R. 104)**  
**Date:** July 23, 2015

COLUMBIA COUNTY, GA – Columbia County, in cooperation with the Georgia Department of Transportation and Reeve’s Construction, Inc., wishes to inform the driving public of a temporary change in the speed limit along a section of Washington Rd (State Route 104). The existing 45 SPEED LIMIT ZONE on Washington Road, between Gibbs Road and William Few Parkway shall be reduced to a 35 SPEED LIMIT ZONE. This section is within the construction limits of the ongoing widening project on Washington Road (SR 104). **Therefore, the maximum speed limit throughout the work zone/construction limits for the widening project is now 35 MPH.**

The change in speed limit zones is scheduled to take effect on Thursday, July 30, 2015. The reduced speed limit throughout this section of the work zone/widening project is to increase the level of safety for construction workers and the public while in this active work zone.

Please proceed with caution thru the work zone/widening project construction limits and allow for additional time for commuting thru this area.
